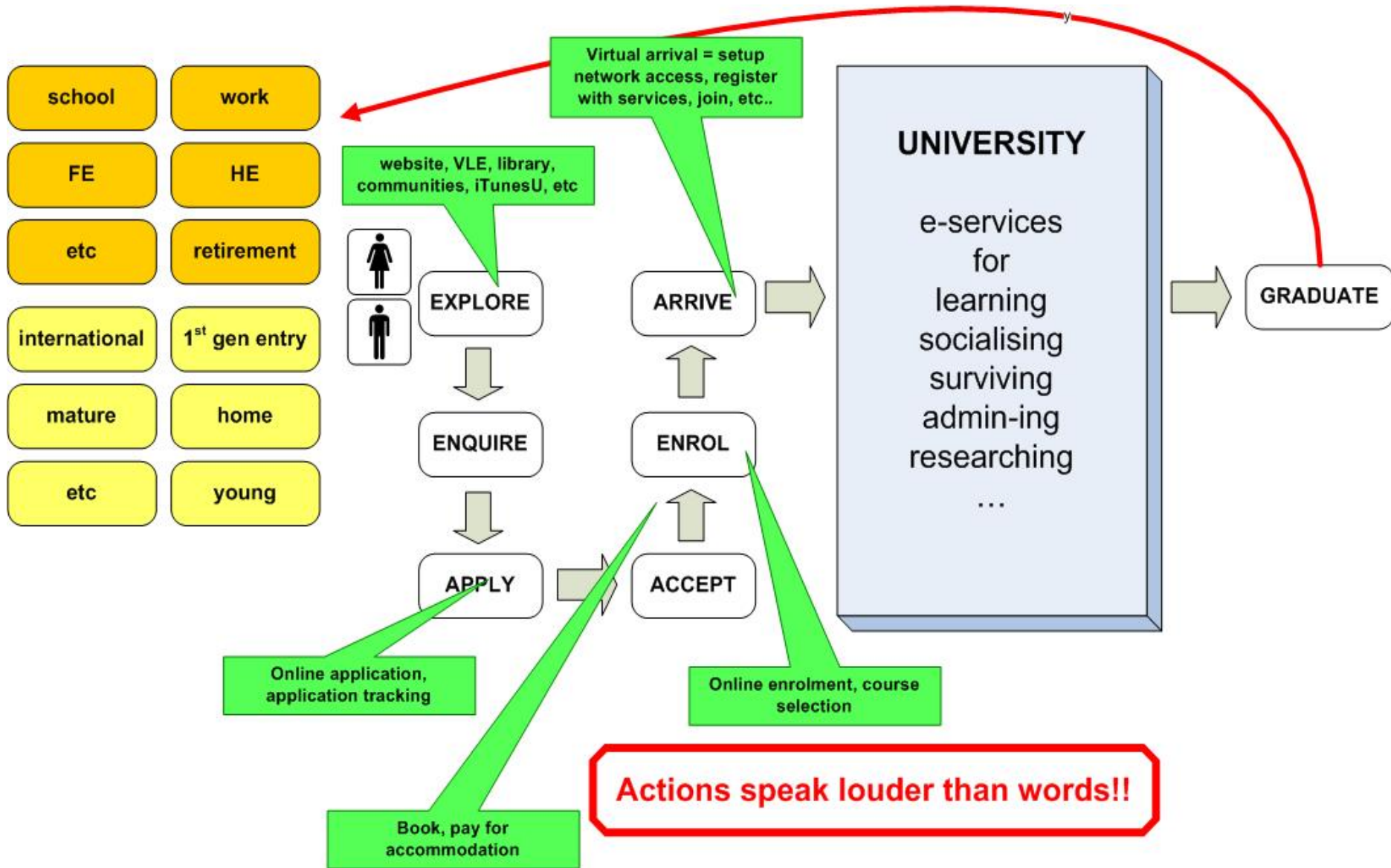

Some current questions for institutions

- With JISC/Ipsos MORI research showing that 50% of prospective students look at a university's IT provision before deciding to apply to that university, what implications does this have for funding decisions?
