The RRT aims to help projects find and exploit synergies across the programme and beyond e.g. gathering scenarios, use cases and workflows from projects, liaising with other national and international repositories activities, including liaison with the e-Framework, synthesizing project and programme outcomes, and engaging with interoperability standards activity and repository</p>		The RRT works across all the programme areas.
