



Digital technologies worth funding, says report

Funding projects to advance digital technologies pays off, says a study by the higher education think-tank million+, which represents newer universities.

The report, *From inputs to impact: a study of the impact of JISC funding on universities*, found that funding from the Joint Information Systems Committee, in projects such as improving student assessment using audio feedback and creating second life learning environments for health workers, had "far ranging impact which was often not limited to the university which had won the JISC award".
